NOTICE

The following notice of intent to construct, submitted in accordance with Section R307-401-1, Utah Air Quality Rules, has been received for consideration by the Executive Secretary, Utah Air Quality Board:

Huish Detergent Incorporated

Location: 3540 West 1987 South, Salt Lake City, Utah 84125

Project Description Huish Detergents Inc. submitted a Notice of Intent to modify Approval Order DAQE-868-01 by adding one natural gas fueled boiler with a heat input of 1.26 x 10⁶ Btu per hour. This source is located in Salt Lake City which is a Nonattainment area of the national air quality standards for PM₁₀, and SO₂, and is a Maintenance area for Ozone and CO.

It has been determined that the conditions of the Utah Administrative Code R307-401-6 and the Federal rules have been met. The Executive Secretary intends to issue an Approval Order after a 30-day public comment period is held. This comment period is being held to receive and evaluate public input on the project proposed by Huish Detergents Inc.

The Proposed Emissions increase will be:

PM ₁₀	0.06 tons/year
NO _x	0.66 tons/year
CO	0.76 tons/year
VOC	0.20 tons/year

The completed engineering evaluation and air quality impact analysis showed that no new violations of National Ambient Air Quality Standards or Prevention of Significant Deterioration Increments will occur. It is the intent of the Executive Secretary to approve the construction project.

The construction proposal and estimate of the effect on local air quality are available for public inspection and comment at the Utah Division of Air Quality, Department of Environmental Quality, 150 North 1950 West, Salt Lake City, Utah 84114-4820. Any questions may be directed to Milka Radulovic at (801) 536-4232, Email: milkar@utah.gov. There will be a 30-day comment period held. Written comments received by the Division, at the same address on or before September 3, 2002, will be considered in making the final decision on the approval/disapproval of the proposed construction.

If anyone so requests to the Executive Secretary at the Division in writing, within 15 days of publication of the Notice, a hearing will be held to explain the project and technical rationale for the proposed action. The hearing will be scheduled as close as practicable to the proposed project location. Comments obtained during the hearing will be evaluated and considered by the Executive Secretary before making a final decision on the approval/disapproval of the project.
