

ANNIE WELLS CANNON

Annie Wells Cannon was born in Salt Lake City. She graduated from the University of Deseret in 1879. Cannon was an activist for women's suffrage and was a member of the Utah State Legislature from 1913-1915 and again in 1921.

She was very active in community affairs and was president of the Daughters of the Utah Pioneers, first president of the War Mothers of Utah, and a charter member of the Utah Red Cross. Cannon was also chosen by Herbert Hoover to be Utah's chairman for the European Relief Drive, of which she was the only woman member.
