THIS IS A COMPETITIVE PROGRAM.
WE HAVE VERY LIMITED FUNDS FOR 2009.
\$410,000 is available this year.

The LeRay McAllister Program provides grants to preserve or restore critical open or agricultural land in Utah. Matching funds are required.

Counties, cities, towns, the Utah Dept. of Natural Resources, the Utah Dept. of Agriculture and Food, and tax exempt organizations may apply for funds.

Before starting, be sure you have read all the documents listed here:

It is important that you know what will be required before a grant can be awarded so that you will be prepared to submit the required documentation.

Due to limited funds, the Commission agreed to the following limitations.

1. LeRay McAllister Funding will not be more than 20 percent of the total project cost for 2009 projects.
2. A single Consolidated Application will be required this year instead of the usual two round process
