<p>Agency Mission</p>	<p>The Federal Surplus Program administers and executes the donation of federal surplus property to eligible State, Education, County, City, and non-profit agencies dealing specifically with health, education or the homeless. This property must be used exclusively by the eligible agency within certain time frames and for the legal missions of their programs. Property is obtained from local and out-of-state Federal agencies and military installations for donation by the above mentioned organizations. Eligibility can be determined by completing and submitting an eligibility form for review. Once eligibility has been granted, federal equipment may be donated to eligible agencies for a service and handling charge based upon the original acquisition cost.</p> <p>The State Surplus Property Program administers and executes the disposal of state owned surplus personal property to state and local governmental agencies as well as to the general public. This equipment includes vehicles, heavy equipment, data processing equipment, office furniture, and any other state-owned personal property. State surplus property is sold for current market value via normal store sales, auctions, and sealed bids. The business hours are Tuesday through Thursday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.</p>
