Purpose of the Program	To oversee and execute the transfer of Federal surplus property to eligible State, County, City, agencies as well as non-profit organizations dealing specifically with health, education, or the homeless within guidelines set forth in the State Plan of Operation.	
Eligible Applicants	State agencies, county governmental agencies, local governmental agencies, education, higher education, and non-profit/tax-exempt organizations that deal specifically with health, education, or the homeless.	
Restrictions on Use of Assistance	Use of Federal property is restricted to eligible agencies under the guidelines set forth by the General Services Administration of the Federal Government. This program does not provide property intended for sale to the general public, however, public auctions are held annually on Federal surplus inventory that is not donated to eligible agencies within a set period of time.	
Application Procedures	Complete and submit a Federal Eligibility Form to Utah State Agency for Surplus Property for review. Agencies meeting the eligibility criteria will be notified of such.
