Purpose of the Program		Provides funding support for sponsors who wish to have an artist on site for 10 to 260 days and/or implement arts education projects. Provides technical assistance in arts education to both artists and non-profit organizations.	
Eligible Applicants		Organizations who have designated non-profit status from the IRS; i.e., schools, colleges, hospitals, social service organizations, nursing homes, prisons, museums, senior centers, etc.	
Restrictions on Use of Assistance		Must follow residency and project program guidelines, i.e., target groups, size limitations of class size, inservice opportunities.

Application Deadline		March 1 of every year except Special Assistance Grant which has no deadline.	
Range and Average of Financial Assistance		All grants have a 1:1 match requirement. Arts education projects: entry level, max \$3,000; arts plan implementation, max \$12,000; community arts, max \$12,000; Underserved Communities, max \$12,000; innovation, max \$12,000. Artist residency grants: Entry level, max one per school/organization; Regular residency, max, 1 per school/organization. Professional Development: For teachers and school administrators only, max \$2,000. Special Assistance: \$1,000 max. for underserved projects only, and limited to applicants who have not received regular grant funds; may only receive two times.
