Eligible Applicants		Community arts organizations (presenting and producing arts programs) and other non-arts organizations including chambers of commerce, schools, etc. Also, performing artists, artistic companies.	
Restrictions on Use of Assistance		Must be nonprofit to obtain UPAT subsidy.	
Application Procedures		For technical assistance, contact the program by phone or mail. UPAT roster has a written application and a taped or live audition process. Sponsors of UPAT performances must complete a sponsor questionnaire. Artist application due May 15, 2001.
