Purpose of the Program	Assists community drinking water systems to construct facilities which protect the public health and welfare and meet the needs of the state's growing population. The Drinking Water Board considers applications in conformance with the governing laws and rules and determines what kind of financial assistance to provide and its terms.	
Eligible Applicants	Political subdivisions of the state or privately owned community drinking water systems constructing any work or facility providing drinking water to 25 or more people or 15 or more service connections on an annual basis.	
Restrictions on Use of Assistance	Loan funds may be used for any work or facility associated with the drinking water system in conformance with Utah's Municipal Bond Act and the Drinking Water Board's rules.	
Application Procedures	Applications are considered on an on-going basis, however, applications for the State SRF applications must be received at least four weeks prior to the Drinking Water Board (DWB) meeting at which the applicant wishes to be considered and applicants for the Federal SRF must file a preliminary application for listing on the project priority list at least one month prior to consideration of a final application. A DWB committee will review the applications and staff's evaluation and provide a recommendation to the DWB.	
State Clearinghouse Coordination	None.	
Application Deadline	Applications are considered on an on-going basis but must be received at least four weeks prior to the next scheduled Drinking Water Board meeting at which the applicant wishes to be considered. The Drinking Water Board's finance committee reviews the applications and the staff's report/evaluation and makes a recommendation to the Board for disapproval or approval and the terms and kind of financial assistance.

Matching Formula	Federal	Matching funds are not required, but are looked upon favorably by the Board.
