Purpose of the Program	The 1993 Utah State Legislature enacted the Used Oil Management Act. The Act was promulgated to promote the collection, recycling and reuse of used lubricating oil and safeguard human health and environment from the improper disposal of used oil. Part of this Act allows for the Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste to award grants, as funds are available, for the promotion of used oil recycling with an emphasis on providing used oil collection facilities and programs in rural areas.	
Eligible Applicants	The public, private industry, local governments, special interest groups.	
Restrictions on Use of Assistance	Grants will be awarded for the establishment of the following, with emphasis on providing used oil collection facilities and programs in rural areas: establishment of regularly scheduled or on-call curbside collection for used oil, construction or improvement of permanent facilities for used oil collection, public education, expansion of existing used oil collection programs, assistance to a private entity for initial or ongoing expenses associated with offering free collection of used oil to the public, purchase of equipment and support for collection of used oil, purchase or retrofitting of vehicles for curbside collection and used oil collection facilities at marinas.
