<b>Purpose of the Program</b>	Make loans and grants to political subdivisions to finance all or part of municipal wastewater or storm water project costs; or make loans to individuals for nonpoint source or septic tank systems.	
<b>Eligible Applicants</b>	All political subdivisions of the state which appear or could be considered for inclusion on the Utah Wastewater Project Priority List. Hardship grants are available only for communities which cannot afford loans. For grants, the cost for sewer service should be at least 1.4% of Median Adjusted Household Income, based on the latest Federal tax returns. Individuals may apply for nonpoint source or septic system loans.	
<b>Restrictions on Use of Assistance</b>	All assistance authorizations are subject to availability of funds. Funds can only be used for costs related to planning, design, and construction of projects which relate to water quality improvement. Recipients may be subject to the requirements of Title II of the Clean Water Act. See Contact for details.
