Eligible Applicants	Local Education Agency, Community-based organization, public or private non-profit agency, Institution of Higher Education, volunteer organization, library.		
Restrictions on Use of Assistance	Funds may be used to pay for most direct costs required to provide Adult Basic instruction and instructional support services. (below 8.9 grade level)		
Application Procedures	Depending upon the availability of funds, the State Office of Education provides forms, instructions, and guidelines for application.
