<b>Purpose of the Program</b>		Provides USDA donated food commodities to public and private non-profit institutions and programs that provide group nutrition (meal) services to eligible persons.	
<b>Eligible Applicants</b>		All schools/institutions participating in the Child Nutrition Program; correctional facilities; group homes; charitable institutions; rehabilitation residential treatment centers; disaster organizations.	
<b>Restrictions on Use of Assistance</b>		Foods may only be used in meals served to qualified individuals.	
<b>Application Procedures</b>		Schools/institutions participating in the Child Nutrition Program are automatically eligible; other institutions submit application form. Private non-profit organizations must submit evidence of tax exempt status under the Internal Revenue Code.	
<b>State Clearinghouse Coordination</b>		per E.O. 12372	
<b>Application Deadline</b>		ongoing	
<b>Range and Average of Financial Assistance</b>		Food assistance only established by meals served and/or poverty/unemployment statistics.	
<b>Source of Funds and Aid</b>		Funds authorized under the National School Lunch Act of 1966, and as made available by the USDA.
