<b>Purpose of the Program</b>		This program is designed to help provide school-age students with disabilities an appropriate education and training opportunity. As a supplemental discretionary appropriation to the "Regular School District Special Education Program" of the Minimum School Finance Program, these funds are restricted by specific state rules and regulations.	
<b>Eligible Applicants</b>		All local school districts who provide services to children who are determined to have a disability by a multi-disciplinary diagnostic team, and for whom an IEP has been developed and implemented are eligible.	
<b>Restrictions on Use of Assistance</b>		Must be spent for services to students with disabilities.
