Purpose of the Program		These funds are federally-dedicated to be transmitted both on formula and at the State's discretion. They are generated by the annual December 1st count of students with handicaps (ages 3-21) receiving a free, appropriate, public education. Thus, use is restricted by specific state rules and federal regulations.	
Eligible Applicants		All local school districts who provide services to children who are determined by a multi-disciplinary diagnostic team to have a disability, and for whom an IEP has been developed and implemented are eligible.	
Restrictions on Use of Assistance		Within limits established by regulations, IDEA-Part B funds may be used to pay costs directly attributable to the special education program. These funds are restricted to special education programs. 75% is flow-through; remainder is discretionary with the State.	
Application Procedures		Applications must be submitted on the SARS Standard Application Form. This application and a listing of current statewide thrusts may be obtained by contacting the local education agency's special education technical assistant. The standard application requires detailed budget information and justification; goals, objectives, and activities to accomplish the proposed project; and evaluation procedures. A final report is required prior to the final reimbursement of awarded funds. Technical assistance is available for the development of applications.
