Purpose of the Program		The program is to provide training for mathematics and science teachers according to the following needs: (1) secondary teachers who are not endorsed in math or science subject areas they are teaching, (2) secondary and elementary teachers who are properly endorsed but who need to improve their teaching skills, increase their knowledge, and/or improve their instructional materials, (3) secondary teachers who are currently teaching mathematics or science and are required to teach those courses, (4) serve the instructional needs of teachers from underrepresented groups.		
Eligible Applicants		Local education agencies who submit an application with an appropriate plan to use the funds as required by the Eisenhower Mathematics/Science Act.		
Restrictions on Use of Assistance		Expenses attributable to planning and implementation of appropriate in-service training programs are allowable. These may include stipends, materials for in-service, consultant, and instructor fees.		
Application Procedures		RFPs are sent to the districts from USOE, and completed forms typically should be returned by October 31.
