Purpose of the Program	The state-equalized Basic School Program helps school districts provide reasonably-equal educational opportunities to all Utah children, regardless of residence or economic status.	
Eligible Applicants	School districts must meet deadlines for submitting reports necessary to calculate relative shares of state funds. Allocations are expended in two general categories of programs: <u>Regular Basic School</u> funds are largely unrestricted, and <u>Restricted Basic School</u> funds may only be expended in specified areas.	
Restrictions on Use of Assistance	Direct costs are allowed for all programs; indirect costs are only allowed as shown on the "Indirect Costs Schedule for State Programs."

Source of Funds and Aid	Minimum School program funds are allocated to school districts based on formulas and standards found in Utah Code 53A-17a and Administrative Rule R277-400-913. Preliminary allocations are made based on interim information from districts. Final allocations are made based on audited statistical, financial, and program reports. Funds can only be disbursed to school districts and related institutions.
